PPP QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Q. What are the benefits of the PPP?

A. This program allows participants to increase their skills and improve their qualifications for a fraction of the normal cost. This may mean promotion to higher duties in the workplace. As the courses are held in regional areas, participants have the opportunity to network with other local operators/employees.

Q. How much is the 10% contribution?

A. For the following qualifications participants will need to contribute:

Qualification	Total Cost	Your Cost
Certificate IV in Hospitality (Commercial Cookery)	\$7000	\$700
Diploma of Hospitality	\$6000	\$600
Diploma of Tourism	\$6000	\$600
Advanced Diploma of Hospitality	\$8000	\$800
Advanced Diploma of Tourism	\$8000	\$800

Q. How will the courses be assessed?

A. We will encourage participants to develop workplace projects and use real documentation (such as policies and procedures) to complete the assignments that are necessary for achieving the qualification.

Q. How long will it take to complete a qualification?

A. It could take up to 2 years to complete a qualification, however depending on the participant's existing skills and experience they may finish sooner.
